

## Summary of Changes between Draft Copy and Final Report of Southern Meade County Corridor Study

1. Page iv - Abbreviations and Acronyms:
  - a. Added: TMC - Turning Movement Count
2. Page 1 - Executive Summary, Study Process:
  - a. Changed from: “Ultimately, **one alternative** was recommended based on the purpose and need, landowner impacts, safety, constructability, and cost.”
  - b. Changed to: “Ultimately, **Alternative 5** was recommended based on the purpose and need, landowner impacts, safety, constructability, and cost.”
3. Page 3 - Executive Summary, Study Findings and Recommendations, Recommended Alternative:
  - a. Changed from: “The identified corridor would **allow the preservation of a future route** and ensure appropriate access management for any potential growth within the area.”
  - b. Changed to: “The identified corridor would **serve as a guide for future development** and ensure appropriate access management for any potential growth within the area.”
4. Page 8 – Additional Goals and Objectives
  - a. Changed from: To manage growth within the framework of the Meade County Comprehensive ~~Plan~~ Land Use Plan and other comprehensive ~~municipal~~ plans (Meade County Comprehensive Plan).
  - b. Changed to: To manage growth within the framework of the Meade County Comprehensive Land Use Plan and other **municipal** comprehensive plans (Meade County Comprehensive Plan).
5. Page 12 – Study Advisory Team Meetings
  - a. Dates updated for presentations to the RCAMPO Committee and Meade County Commission
  - b. Added “RCAMPO” prior to the names of the three committees
6. Page 12 – Public Open House Meetings
  - a. Removed text: Open house meetings were held to gather feedback from the **general, traveling** public and landowners within the Study Area.
  - b. Inserted text shown in bold under the Public Meeting #2 section: This public meeting was held concurrent with the **individual** landowner meetings. Landowners were encouraged to attend the public meeting as well.
7. Page 13 – Landowner Meetings
  - a. Changed from: “Many landowners were **against** the project and preferred the no-build alternative.”
  - b. Changed to: “Many landowners were **not in favor of** the project and preferred the no-build alternative.”

8. Page 16 –
  - a. Deleted text: The Study Area is outside of the Ellsworth AFB Safety Military Compatibility Area. However, the Ellsworth AFB Noise Military Compatibility Area does overlap with the eastern half of the Study Area, which has **some** building guidelines.
9. Page 17 - Exhibit 3
  - a. Changed the location of the label for the City of Piedmont
10. Page 46 – Purpose and Need, Build Alternatives
  - a. Changed from: Each alternative will provide a corridor that will accommodate planned growth, which can be **preserved for** orderly and efficient development.
  - b. Changed to: Each alternative will provide a corridor that will accommodate planned growth, which can be **used as a tool to provide** orderly and efficient development.
11. Page 48, Preliminary Intersection Geometrics
  - a. Added text shown in bold: Due to topographical constraints and a large stream crossing, the intersection of Haines Avenue and Alternative 4 could not be located far enough away from a crest vertical curve **such that it** didn't impede the intersection sight distance.
12. Page 49, Conceptual Construction Cost Estimate Comparisons
  - a. Added text shown in bold: Some bid items could not be quantified and the associated costs are assumed to be included in the 40% **planning level** contingency.
